

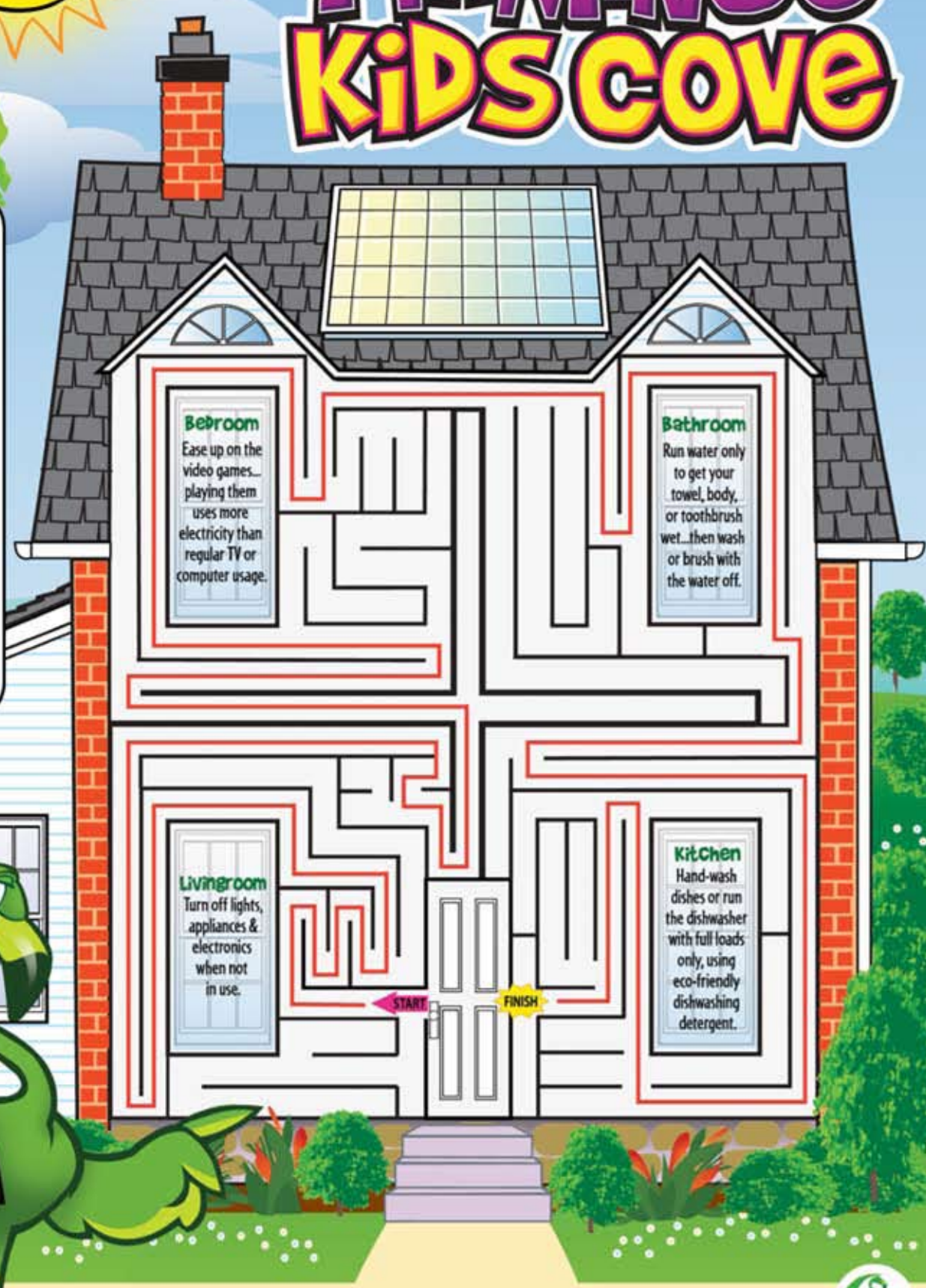


# ISAAC'S FLAMINGO KIDS COVE

### Kitchen

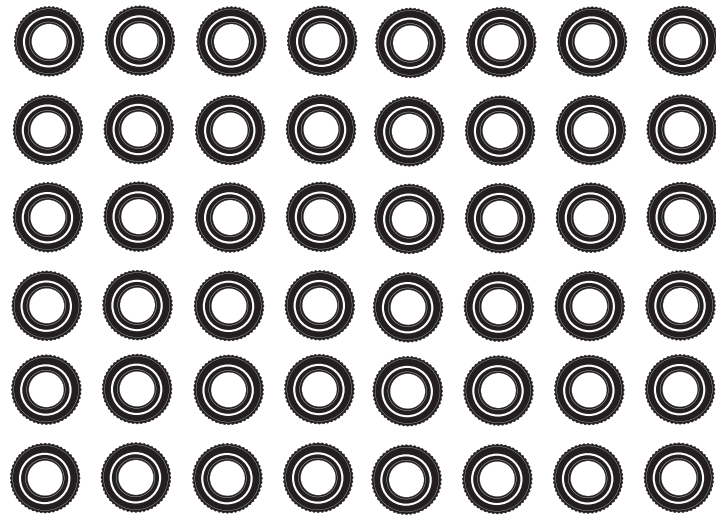
Hand-wash dishes or run the dishwasher with full loads only, using eco-friendly dishwashing detergent.

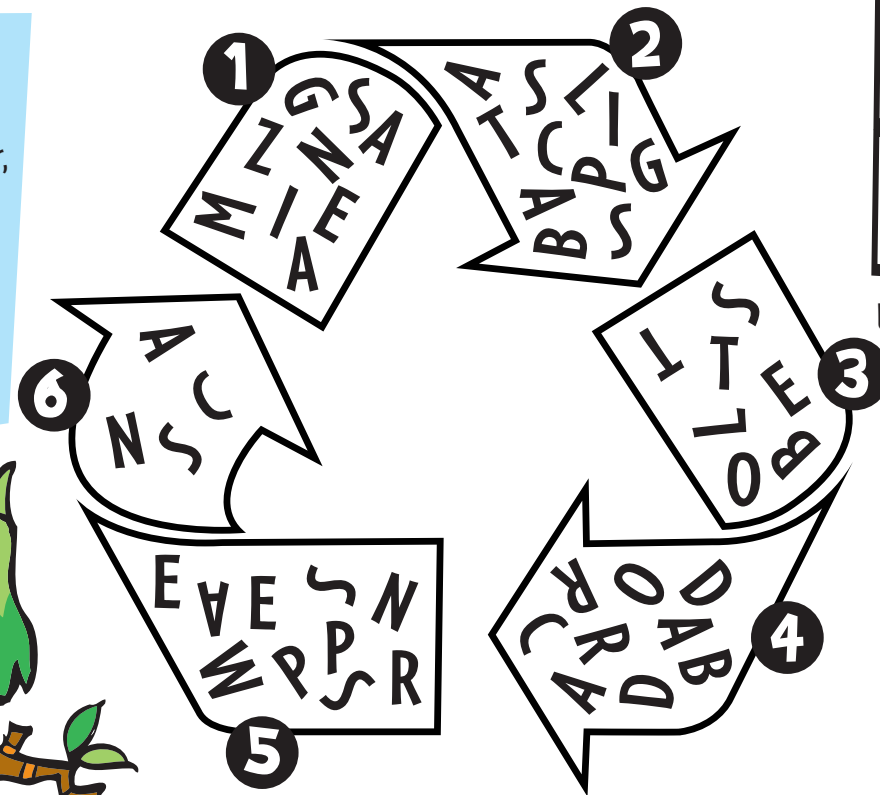
# Tire collection game

Fluorescent light bulbs last up to 10 times longer, use 1/4 the energy and produce 90% less heat, while producing more light per watt, than incandescent bulbs?



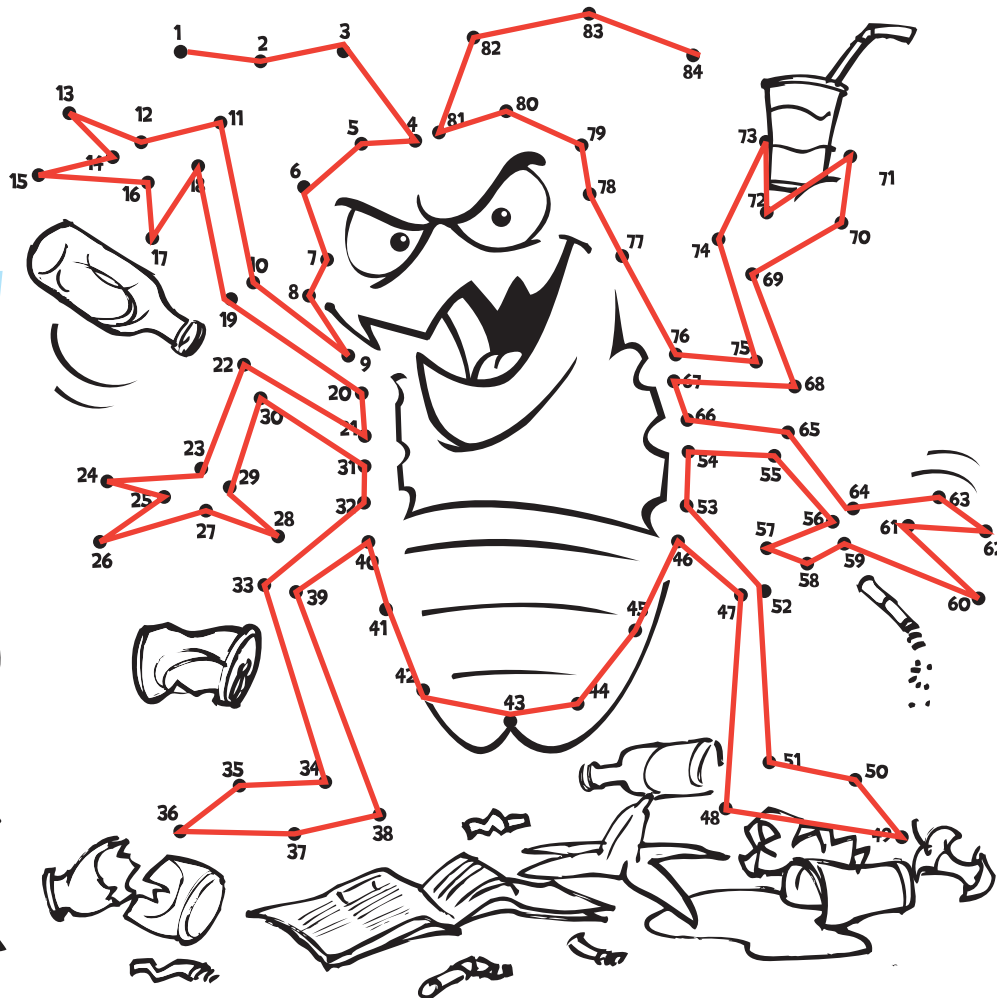

You will become one of these if you litter! Connect the dots to find out what you don't ever want to be!



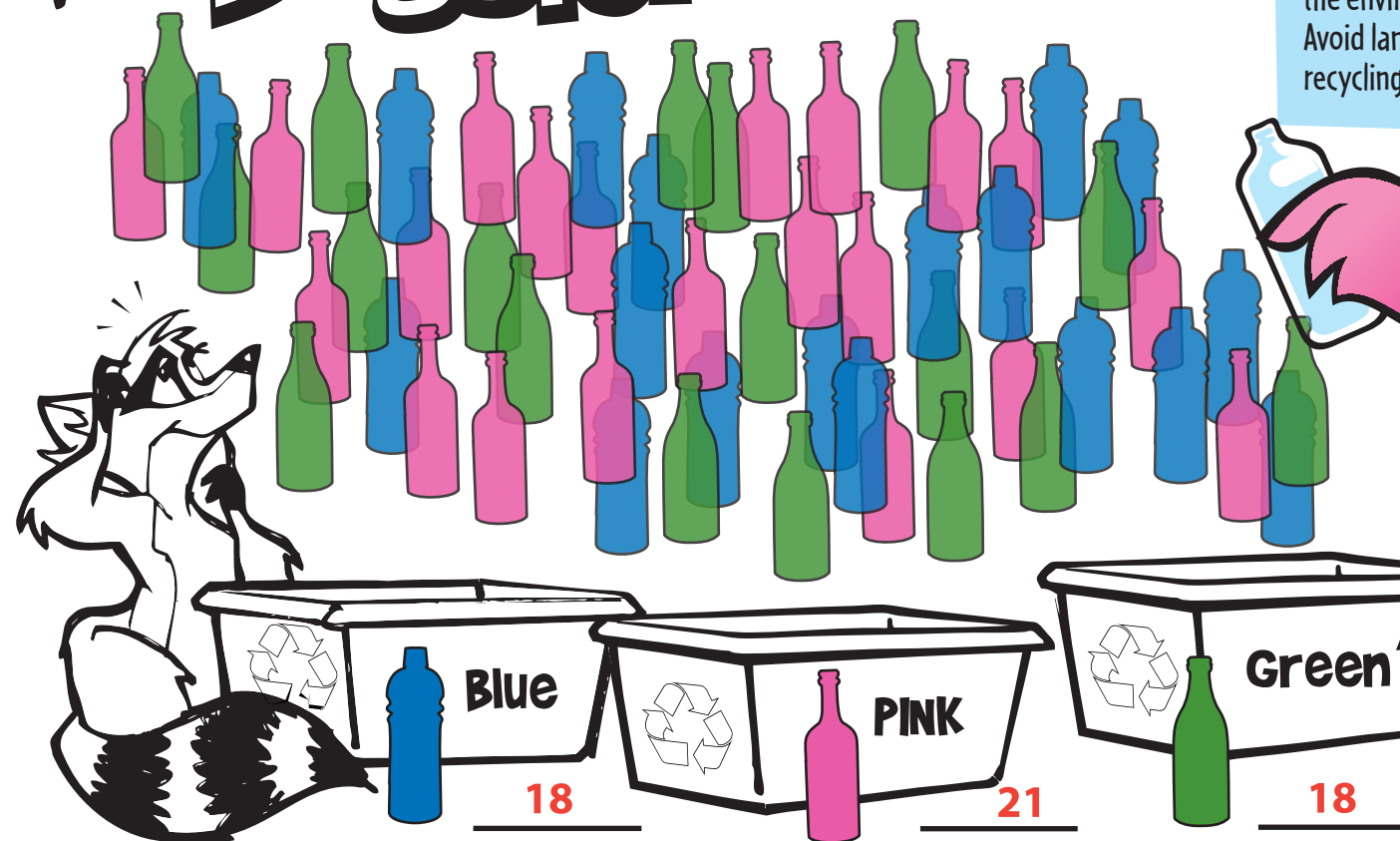
## Didjknow?
